Tuition:

In June, we move to the new school year schedule, so tuition will change to the 2019-2020 amounts. Invoices will be sent soon via email/QuickBooks for June tuition.

Please remember to either leave a check with us to deposit in June or mail one before the past due date of June 5. After June 5, there will be a \$50 late fee added to the account. Tuition is due on the first of each month and past due after the 5th.

In July, there is no tuition payment, but there is the supply fee payment. Then, August through May will be the regular tuition plus any late stay. You may need to adjust your online bill pays with your bank. We are attaching the tuition schedule for your review.
