This week are continuing to learn about colors and shapes. Today we read a fun book about a color clown who mixes primary colors to get secondary colors. We did a color mixing lesson with food coloring after. They loved it!

We are seeing a few issues with lunches. Each lunch should include a protein, grain, vegetable, dairy, and fruit. There have been a few that are missing some of the food groups. Our lunches can be inspected by Bright from The Start, the state regulatory agency when they visit, and the school can receive a citation. Please make sure to put hot and cold foods in separate containers. It makes it difficult to warm up lunches if they are together,

and lunch is a hectic time getting all the little ones fed and ready for nap. Food should be something that your child can manage on their own. It needs to be cut and ready for them to eat. Thank you for remembering your ice packs and silverware daily.

We go out every day unless it is actively raining. They are toddlers and will get dirty because they sit down on the rocks or dig in the rocks with the buckets and shovels, or draw with sidewalk chalk. It is best to send them in play clothes and tennis shoes. They look so cute when they walk in the door and messy when they leave us, but that means they are having fun!

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We will go to the library on Thursdays. We will send their book home on in their bag. Please return book and bag on Wednesdays.

Hello! It was so good to see so many of you at the back to school picnic. If you were not able to make it, you can find your Daddy's Day gift in your child's cubby.

Nap Rolls- Be sure to bring back nap rolls on Monday mornings. You or your child can bring the nap rolls right into the classroom. Please be sure to take them home each Friday so you can wash them.

Readers- I am still waiting for a few readers to be sent back to school from this summer. Please be sure to send them back. I really want to start readers this week. Readers need to be sent back on Mondays and Thursdays. A good way to work on readers is to make it part of your nightly routine. Your child does not need to read the whole reader in one sitting. Of course if they want to, that is awesome! Reading a few pages each night is perfect. The children do need to practice their reader each day but we do not want them to get frustrated. We want them to not only learn to read but to love to read.

Library Books- The children loved going to the library on Thursday. They learned how to take care of the books and how to check them out. Your child will need to bring back their library books in their library bag every Thursday. Unfortunately, if your child does not bring their library book back, they will be unable to check out a new book. Please continue to teach your child how to handle the books nicely at home.

Sand Paper Letters- In Montessori schools, we learn the letters sounds first not the letter names. In our first step on your child's journey to reading, we will learn all the letter sounds using sand paper letters. You will start seeing your child come home with letters written on their hand. We do this to help them learn and retain the letter sound. A great activity to do with them, on the way home, is to ask your child what sound the letter makes and then try to come up with words together that start with that sound. For example: apple, alligator, and astronaut start with the letter "a." As the children learn the letters you can also play I Spy. (I spy something that starts with "c") Please be sure to use the letter sound and not the letter names. The children will learn the letter names later and it can confuse them right now to learn the names.

Third year homework and book bags- (This only pertains to the children who are in Ms. Angie's afternoon class.) I hope everyone picked up their child's homework folder on Friday. These will be due back on Thursdays and then new homework will be sent out on Fridays. Your child is welcome to bring their homework back in a book bag. The book bag will go straight into Ms. Angie's classroom, so she can check the homework and put the new homework in. Your child will then take their book bag home on Friday.

The children are loving learning all about space. Be sure to ask them about the planets and the sun.
