Copper Creek Farm – Toddler/Primary Field Trip Reminder – Friday, October 13th

We are looking forward to another great year at Copper Creek Farm for our Toddler/Primary Field Trip this Friday, October 13th!

Please plan to arrive to Copper Creek Farm (located at <u>1514 Reeves Station Rd SW, Calhoun, GA 30701</u>) with your child between 9:00-9:15am on Friday. Students should wear their black MSOR Field Trip shirts. Parents will need to get in line to purchase admission for yourselves and for your child(ren). The line can sometimes back up on Fridays, so arriving closer to 9:00am is recommended. Copper Creek accepts cash, check, or credit/debit cards but please keep in mind there is a 4% service charge for credit/debit cards.

The farm tour will begin between 9:30-9:45am and there are lots of stations to visit. Our field trip is treated like a group outing, so parents are asked to serve as chaperones for their own children. Our Toddler and Primary Teachers will also be there to help guide the group(s) along.

Following the tour, you are welcome to have lunch onsite with your child or leave to have lunch elsewhere. You may purchase lunch onsite or you may also bring a picnic lunch to enjoy at the tables but you are responsible for it during the tour.

Following the field trip, students will be dismissed from Copper Creek Farm and will not return to school. Enjoy this afternoon with family and we encourage our students to rest and prepare for our annual Fall Festival that same evening beginning at 5:30pm. There will be food and artisan goods available for purchase (cash only). We look forward to welcoming everyone back for an exciting evening celebrating the season!
