Science Fair:

- -After tomorrow, March 26, we are sending all science boards home. We have worked in class for several weeks, and the final portion is being sent home to complete. Students will be fully responsible for completing DATA, RESULTS, AND CONCLUSION Sections at home.
- -Titles are to be in Times New Roman font, size 48. All titles are to be centered. Body text is to be in Times New Roman font, size 24. All body text is to be in FULL justification (not centered).
- Students need to bring in their <u>finished</u> boards on MONDAY, March 31. This includes colored PICTURES for the center part of the board.
- The whole science experiment itself must be brought to school on WEDNESDAY, April 2. This will allow us to arrange the classroom for the school science fair walk-through on THURSDAY MORNING, April 3.
- The official Science Fair Presentation is on APRIL 3, at Willingham Gymnasium, from 5:45-7:00pm. Every student is required to attend, and all students are required to remain for the entire Science Fair so that graders can hear all presentations. Teachers will handle the transportation of experiments to the gym. Professional Attire is expected from all Science Fair presenters. Student Attendance gets taken at 5:30pm, please have your student at Willingham Gymnasium no later than 5:30pm.

Tennis:

Because Science Fair falls on a Thursday, we will be having a double tennis session for 4th and 5th years THIS Thursday, March 27, to make up for the missed day next week. Friday tennis for 6th years will occur as normal.
