MSOR Food Drive - November 12th-19th

7 Days. 500 Backpacks. Thousands of meals.

With Thanksgiving just around the corner it is a time for counting the blessings that surround us. But – Did you know? In Rome/Floyd County there is an estimated food insecurity rate of 16%. MSOR students have decided to lead an effort to help provide meals to children facing food insecurity right here in our town and surrounding areas. Over the next 7 days, we are setting a goal to provide the food contents for 500 backpacks to be distributed through Northwest Georgia Hunger Ministries... and we need your help!





DID YOU KNOW?

- Statewide, about 19.6% (roughly 1 in 5) of children in Georgia are estimated to live in food-insecure households.
- In the Rome/Floyd County area, there is an estimated food insecurity rate of 16%.
- Northwest Georgia Hunger Ministries fills and distributes 2,000 Backpack Buddies a week. This program provides meals to kids over the weekends who are experiencing food insecurity.

WHAT IS MSOR DOING TO HELP!

We aim to collect enough food to pack 500 backpacks for children, and we need your help! To teach students the joy of giving, we encourage you to involve your child in the process. Allowing children to shop for specific items promotes important lessons about generosity. If you can't shop together, our older students will shop on your behalf and run an on-site "store" where students can purchase items with their own money. This ensures that every child has the opportunity to participate in giving back.

This week in our transportation unit, we talked about things that fly. We learned about hot air balloons, bi-planes, seaplanes, jets, helicopters, stunt planes, and the space shuttle. We watched some videos, and the children were amazed by the Blue Angels. They were so excited to see them fly upside down and in loops. They also loved to see the seaplane take off and land on the water. They were amazed to see the fire shooting from the boosters when the space shuttle lifted off. We also had a great time discussing the airport.

We had our first cold day today! Please check the weather before dressing your children for school. We go out at 10. It was cold and windy. We go out every day unless it is below freezing. Your child needs to have a labeled coat, mittens, and a hat. If you don't want to worry about bringing them each day, you can leave a set of these at school. Let me know if you are sending in a school set so we won't send them back home at the end of the day.

We have several children who are potty training. If your child is potty training, it is important to be consistent and not switch between underwear and diapers. You can always layer them if you are going out and need extra protection. They also need a few labeled outfits, including extra shoes. If dirty clothes go home, clean ones need to come in the following day.
