MSOR Holiday Program & Rehearsal Details

We are so excited for the Holiday Program to take place one week from today on Tuesday, December 16th! Our students, faculty, and musicians have been working tirelessly to bring you an exciting evening you are sure to love. We can't wait to see you there!

Please note: There will be a required morning rehearsal at the Rome City Auditorium on the morning of our performance (Tuesday, December 16th) for all programs Primary and older (Toddlers will not attend).

Please see below for our rehearsal schedule:

Toddler: Toddlers <u>will not attend</u> our morning rehearsal at the Rome City Auditorium on Tuesday, December 16th. Toddlers may treat that day like a regular school day, however, if you wish to keep your child home to rest before the big concert you are more than welcome to do so. Toddlers should plan to arrive at the Rome City Auditorium that evening no later than 5:30pm and should be fully dressed and ready to go. **Please note, Late Stay will end at 4:15pm and all Toddler/Primary students must be picked up prior to that time.**

Primary: Primary students <u>will attend</u> our morning rehearsal on Tuesday, December 16th and should plan to arrive at the Rome City Auditorium at 8:30am. Parents, please be sure to only utilize designated "Guest" parking or the public parking decks only – cars that do not park where they should will be ticketed and towed! **Pick-up time from the Auditorium is 10:45am for Primary.** Primary students are encouraged to go home from

the rehearsal and rest for the day until the call time of 5:30pm. If your child does return to school, please note Late Stay will end at 4:15pm and all students must be picked up prior to that time.

Lower & Upper Elementary: Lower & Upper Elementary will attend our morning rehearsal on Tuesday, December 16th and should plan to arrive at the Rome City Auditorium at 8:15am. Parents, please be sure to only utilize designated "Guest" parking or the public parking decks only - cars that do not park where they should will be ticketed and towed! Pick-up time from the Auditorium is 11:00am for Lower Elementary and 11:15am for Upper Elementary. Please note Late Stay will end at 4:15pm and all students must be picked up prior to that time. Students should arrive to the Auditorium dressed and ready at 5:30pm.

Reminder: Late Stay will end at 4:15pm on Tuesday, December 16th, and all students must be picked up no later than 4:15pm so everyone has ample time to prepare for the Holiday Program.

The Holiday Program is quickly approaching, and we wanted to share some important details with you:

Costumes: I have sent the girls' dresses home. Please press the dresses without washing or cleaning them to avoid shrinkage or damage. To match the 1940s/50s theme, we ask that girls wear tights and dress shoes, with their hair styled in curls or pulled back with a headband or bow.

For the boys, they should wear either an argyle or a solid V-neck sweater in Christmas colors, paired with a solid or plaid shirt in similar colors. All boys need to wear black or dark navy dress pants, dark dress socks, and dress shoes.

Secret Snowflake: We will be playing two games at our Classroom Christmas Party on December 19th. Each student will draw their Snowflake on Friday [12/12], and the name must remain a secret! Students are only allowed to share their Snowflake's name with their parents.

On the day of the party, each student should bring a wrapped gift valued at \$20, with the recipient's name attached, and place it in a trash bag. The teachers will place it under the tree.

Chinese Firecracker or White Elephant Gift: We will also be playing the annual Firecracker Game, which involves trading, exchanging, and stealing gifts to get the most sought-after item. Students should bring an unwrapped gift valued between \$5 and \$10.

Christmas Party Food: Our traditional Christmas Breakfast will take place on December 19th. If you would like to contribute a breakfast dish or beverage, please reach out to me, [Ms. Shemi]. We want to have a mix of savory and sweet items, along with orange juice and hot cider.
