March was such a fun month! The children were so excited to talk about all the animals that they saw at the zoo! It is time for us to buzz on to April! April will be all about all the fun things that spring brings. This month, we will learn about insects and what makes them special. We will learn different types of insects, what they do for the Earth, and where they live. It's also the perfect month to learn about flowers. We will explore how they grow, learn their parts, plant, and care for them.

This Friday, we will celebrate Easter. Each child needs to bring in twelve stuffed eggs that have been taped shut by Thursday. We encourage you to stuff the eggs with little treats that are not necessarily candy, like stickers, bubbles, etc. If you do stuff your eggs with candy, please no chocolate and be mindful of choking hazards. On Friday, each child will need a basket to hunt eggs with. Please make sure to label the basket. Most parents do not attend the egg hunt because it goes so quickly. We will hunt eggs with the other toddler class. It is usually over in about five minutes. We would love to have a special treat for our snack that day. Please let me know if you would like to send something in.

Gardening Day is Friday, April 24th. This is a day for your child to invite someone special to school to plant a flower with them and celebrate Spring. We will also have a craft to make and a little snack for them to enjoy. A lot of people have grandparents visit this day, but it can be anyone that you would like to invite. We ask that you come in at drop-off to plant with your toddlers. It's hard for them to go through multiple separations, and it's also hard for them to understand why their person isn't here with everyone else's is here planting. We would like everyone to be finished up and gone by 10:00. This gives us time to get them settled back into routine before lunch and nap.
