- Please send your child a labeled sack lunch. Everything must be disposable, including bottled water. Students may not bring their regular water bottles on the field trip. Late stay students should leave their regular water bottles at school and bring an additional disposable one for the trip.
- Please dress your child warmly in clothing they can manage independently; this is mainly an outdoor event. If they get warm and remove a coat they will have to carry it.
- Please drop off labeled booster seats at the front office. We will retrieve them from the benches to put into chaperone cars.
- Students may bring up to \$15.00 for gift shop purchases. Please place the money into a labeled, zip-loc bag for safe keeping.
- We are leaving MSOR at 8:15 and should return by 2:00-2:30.
- Chaperones will each receive emergency contact information for the children they transport.

- If your child is bringing money for the gift shop, please send it in a Ziploc bag labeled with their name.
- **If your child is legally required to be in a car seat, then he or she must use one for the field trip.** Please be sure to drop it off at the office Thursday morning. Thank you!


